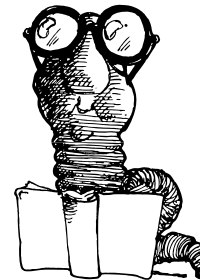


Auxiliary Boat Crew Training Manual Update
